Revisiting The Racehorse

Current Concepts in the veterinary care of the Thoroughbred racehorse

Programme

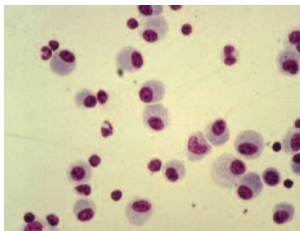
"Revisiting the Racehorse" will address the current concepts in the veterinary care of the racehorse. We are delighted that the course will be opened by the highly successful racehorse trainer and veterinary surgeon Mark Johnston. On **Wednesday** 23rd September the morning session will start with an in depth discussion of intra articular medication in racehorses including the choice of therapeutic agent and a discussion on drug detection and withdrawal periods. This will be followed by a detailed session on the management of subchondral bone pain. In the afternoon the latest advances in the management and treatment of tendonitis will be covered with expert opinion from the UK and North America. The day will be rounded off with a review of the role that new diagnostic modalities such as scintigraphy and MRI play in the management of injuries in racehorses.



On the morning of **Thursday** 24th September current concepts in the diagnosis and management of both upper and lower respiratory disease will be covered. This will include a review of recent data from over ground endoscopy studies. The afternoon will focus on the diagnosis and management of poor performance including cardiovascular assessment, gastric ulceration, rhabdomyolysis and the neurological examination of subtle gait analysis. The course will close with a tour of the Newmarket Equine Hospital.

Speakers

We have gathered together an internationally renowned group of speakers from the UK, North America and Hong Kong. There is a combination of University based expertise and highly experienced racehorse practitioners to bring together accumulated theoretical understanding and practical experience to review the current status of knowledge in the veterinary treatment and management of racehorses. Speakers include Professor Peter Clegg from the University of Liverpool, Professor Paddy Dixon from the University of Edinburgh, Professor Roger Smith from the Royal Veterinary College and Professor Tim Morris from the British Horseracing Authority. In addition Dr Vince Baker from North America and Ben Mason from the Hong Kong Jockey Club will bring an international perspective. Dr Richard Piercy, Dr Lesley Young, Dr Rachel Murray, Dr Mark Hillyer, Ian Wright and Rob Pilsworth will bring their specific expertise to the meeting. Other speakers will include Gaynor Minshall, Justin Perkins, Matt Smith, Meredith Smith, Rob van Pelt and David Dugdale.
